

Immunizations for Travel to Uganda

**Yellow fever	<u>required</u> – must have a medical card stating
*Hepatitis A	2 injections at least 6 weeks apart
*Tetanus	within the last 5 years
*Malaria	oral medication taken before and during the trip, discuss this with your physician
Typhoid	tablets or injection – tablets good for 10 years, injection good for 5 years
Polio	should have one adult dose – lifetime
Hepatitis B	particularly for medical personnel
Meningococcal meningitis	

**Doctor must have a special license to give the yellow fever immunization.
This immunization and its documentation are required to enter Uganda.

*These immunizations are highly suggested but not required.

All others are optional
